### **NOTICE: Change in National Gambling Counselor Certification Criteria**

As of **April 3, 2007** the National Gambling Counselor Certification Board (NGCCB) began requiring a Bachelors Degree or equivalent to meet the behavioral education requirement for certification. This ends and replaces the previous requirement of 300 hours of education from a behavioral health field. All applications for gambling counselor certification received after midnight of **April 3, 2007**, are now subject to the new Bachelors Degree or equivalent requirements.
